

## Reverse Parking.

- 1. Move the car into a position alongside the car you want to park around. Remember that you need to be parallel to the kerb, about an arms length away and in line with the drivers' seat of the other car.*
- 2. As soon as you stop select reverse gear, this will show any vehicles behind that you are going to reverse.*
- 3. Observe all around, if it is safe, start to move, turn 1 whole turn of the wheel to the left, reverse back until your near side door mirror is in line with the front of the other car, turn 1 whole turn to the right, reverse back until your tax disc is in line with the side of the other car.*
- 4. Stop. Observe all around again. If it is safe move and turn 1½ turn to the right, go back until you are almost parallel to the kerb. Finish by turning 1½ turns back to the left ending the manoeuvre parallel to the kerb approximately 6"~12" away.*
- 5. Make the car safe.....manoeuvre finished!*
- 6. This must be completed within 2 car lengths of your car, if correction is needed, go back straight the full 2 car lengths, only correcting the steering as you pull forward, finishing with enough space to pull away.*
- 7. Observation is very important, remember 80% behind and only 20% for mirrors and turning points, they are for guidance only!*
- 8. Coordination of speed and steering is also very important, remember to keep the car slow and your turns need to be applied at those points.*
