

## Reversing around a long corner.

1. Drive past the road on the left hand side and stop so that the corner you intend to reverse around is visible in your near side door mirror. Remember to stop parallel to, and around 12" ~ 18" away from the kerb.
2. After observing all around reverse back until the kerb is visible in the bottom left hand corner of the n/s door mirror.
3. STOP and observe all around again, if it is safe, start to move the car backwards initially turning  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 1 turn. If and when the kerb disappears from the mirror steer another  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn. Keep repeating this  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn every 2-3 feet until the kerb reappears.
4. As you reverse around the corner observe again about half way around. When the kerb reappears start to take off  $\frac{1}{4}$  turns until until the car finishes parallel to the kerb around the same distance away as when you started.
5. Remember coordination of speed and steering is very important
6. Go back until you are asked to stop.
7. Make the car safe.....manoeuvre finished!
8. Remember, observation needs to be behind 80% of the time, the other 20% is for the mirrors and observing around you. If you hear something stop and check!
9. If at any time another vehicle approaches from behind always show willing to go forward and start the manoeuvre again.
